The Daily Connections (Good Morning God, Spiritual Boost, Good Night Review) open our lives to God's love and direction and power.

Good Morning God should be the first thing we do every day when waking up. The *Spiritual Boost* connects us with God's words in the Bible during the day sometime when we have 10 minutes of quiet. Finally, we finish our day with *Good Night Review*, and this allows God's joy and forgiveness to come to us as we drift into sleep.

These three spiritual exercises take only 20 minutes each day, and you will be amazed at how they affect your life. Give it a try and see how you are fundamentally changed by time with God!

Here are suggested readings in the Bible for your **Spiritual Boosts** this week:

Day 1: Read Mark 5:21-23

- ✳ What made Jairus fall at Jesus' feet? Do you feel comfortable approaching Jesus for big miracles? Why or why not?

Day 2: Read Mark 5:24-29

- ✳ Jesus immediately healed the unnamed woman's suffering. Recall a time when Jesus helped you, and thank Him for it. Sit in gratitude.

Day 3: Read Mark 5:30-34

- ✳ Jesus called the isolated woman "daughter" in front of the crowd. Spend some time appreciating God for welcoming you as His own.

Day 4: Read Mark 5:34-36

- ✳ Jesus points out the importance of faith. Ask God to help you have more faith that He can work miracles in and through you.

Day 5: Read Mark 5:37-42

- ✳ When Jesus healed the girl, people were "overwhelmed and totally amazed." How high or low is your amazement about God these days?
